Monthly Herbal Gatherings - On quiet Saturday mornings, we'll greet the land at first light and step into intimate relationship with plants — crafting wild medicines, edible delights, and earth-rooted art. With hands in the soil and hearts open, we'll explore how these plants nourish not only our bodies, but our spirits and communities, too. See you in September!

Let's celebrate the changing of the seasons by honoring the rhythms of the earth and within ourselves. The Seasonal Sunset Series includes four guided gatherings, each aligned with a seasonal threshold — times when nature quietly shifts and invites us to do the same. Together, we'll hike into the beauty of dusk, sip wild-foraged seasonal teas, and settle into guided meditations that invite inward reflection. Each evening culminates in nature journaling and warm fireside connection under the open sky. To support your journey throughout the year, each participant will receive a beautifully crafted seasonal journal, filled with prompts and gentle invitations to deepen your relationship with the land and with yourself between gatherings.

These gatherings are an invitation to begin again — in wonder, in movement, in connection. We'll greet the day with yoga, quiet observation through nature journaling, and meaningful time spent with wild plants.

Each gathering brings us to a different natural area around West Michigan, where we'll get to know the plants of that place — crafting herbal medicines, preparing seasonal foods, and creating art rooted in what the land offers. Most classes will take place within 30 minutes of Grand Rapids, with a few held along the shores of Lake Michigan for a deeper immersion.

The full schedule, with locations for the year ahead, will be shared with enrolled participants in August — giving you time to prepare for a year of rooted mornings spent in kinship with plants, place, and community.



The weather make-up date is one week from the scheduled gathering.

Time to slow down, root deep, and reconnect with the wild wisdom of plants and place. We will connect in the natural world throughout all the seasons, and with one another in meaningful community.

We will be outdoors in many types of weather. Gatherings will likely be postponed if the following is in the forecast

- Thunderstorm warning, tornados or severe weather
- Heat index above 90°
- Wind chill below 0°
- Heavy rain with a wind chill below 45°
- Wind gusts above 35 mph
- Air Quality AQI Index of 150+



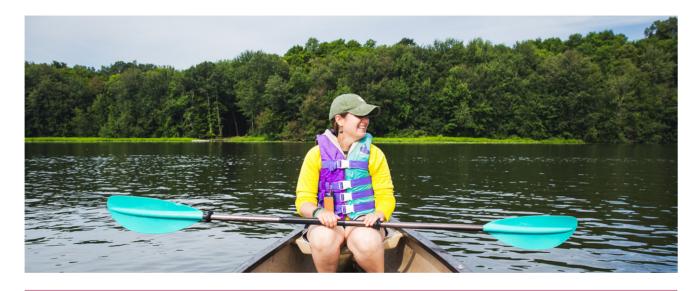
NOTE If we need to cancel due to weather, we'll plan to meet the following Saturday morning. If we have to cancel two weeks in a row, that gathering won't be made up. If more than one gathering is missed over the year, we'll issue a prorated refund at the end of the season in August.



Since we'll be gathering outdoors through all seasons, it's important to come prepared with gear to keep you comfortable in a variety of weather. While we'll postpone for severe storms or heavy rain, we will likely experience some wet or chilly days — and being well-equipped makes all the difference in enjoying the magic of the moment.

- Warm layers to shed as the day warms up
- Optional An umbrella could be helpful for parts of our gathering, but can be hard to manage while working with our hands.

What is the difference between Seasonal Celebrations and Monthly Herbal Gatherings? Can I do both?

We'd love for you to join us for both if it feels aligned! Each offering holds its own rhythm and beauty. The Seasonal Sunset Series meets four evenings a year (equinoxes + solstices) for reflection, tea, and fireside connection. The Monthly Herbal Gatherings are hands-on Saturday mornings with yoga, plantcraft, and nature journaling. *Sign up for both and receive \$50 off.

Can I come just a few times, rather then committing to the whole year?

This course is designed to unfold gently over time, with each gathering deepening our connection to the land, the plants, and one another. We've found that having a consistent circle of women creates a strong container for trust, growth, and shared discovery.

That said, life has its seasons — and if a monthly rhythm feels like too much right now, we invite you to consider joining us for just the Seasonal Sunset Series. These four gatherings are spacious, grounding, and a beautiful way to stay connected to the turning wheel of the year.
